

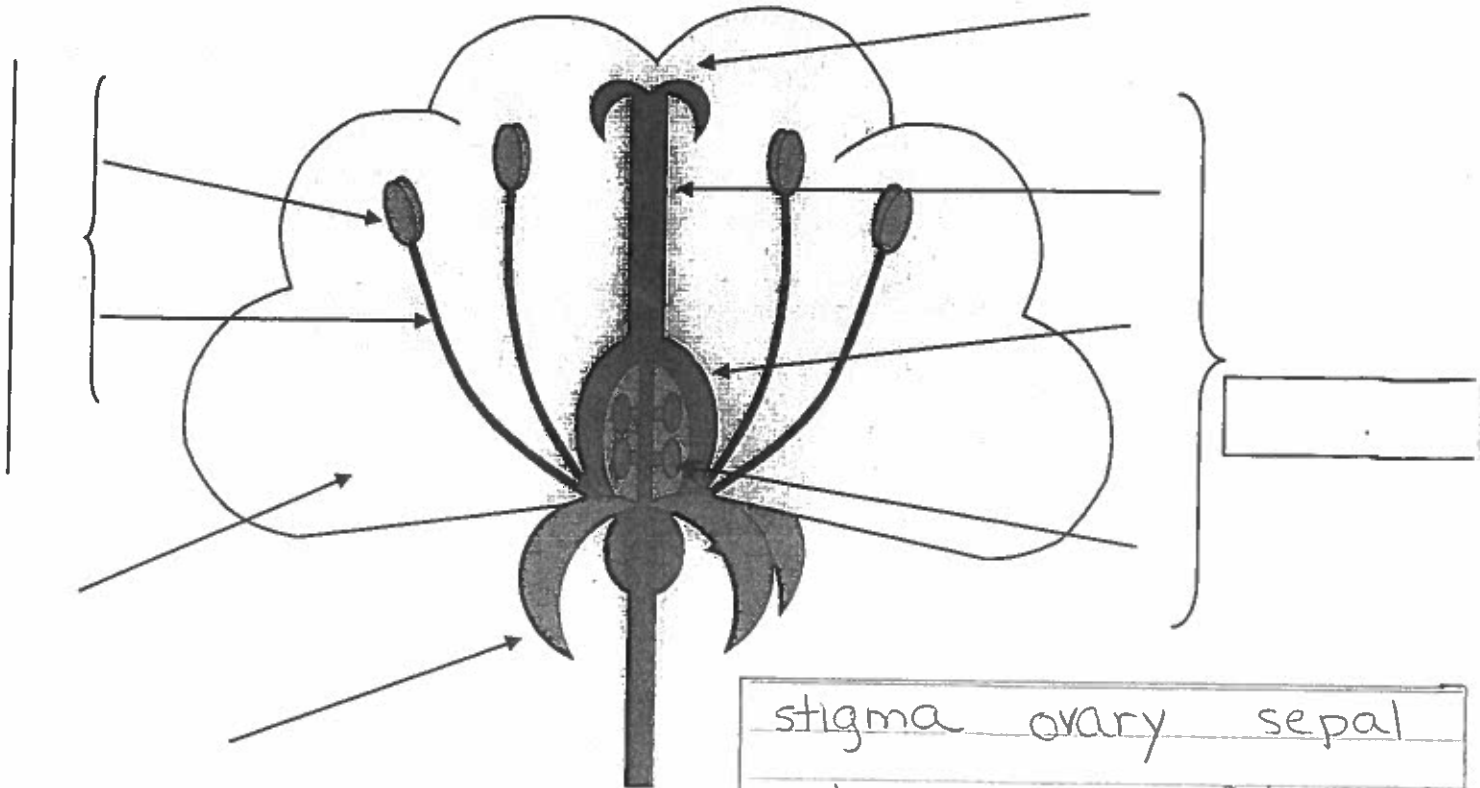

style stem

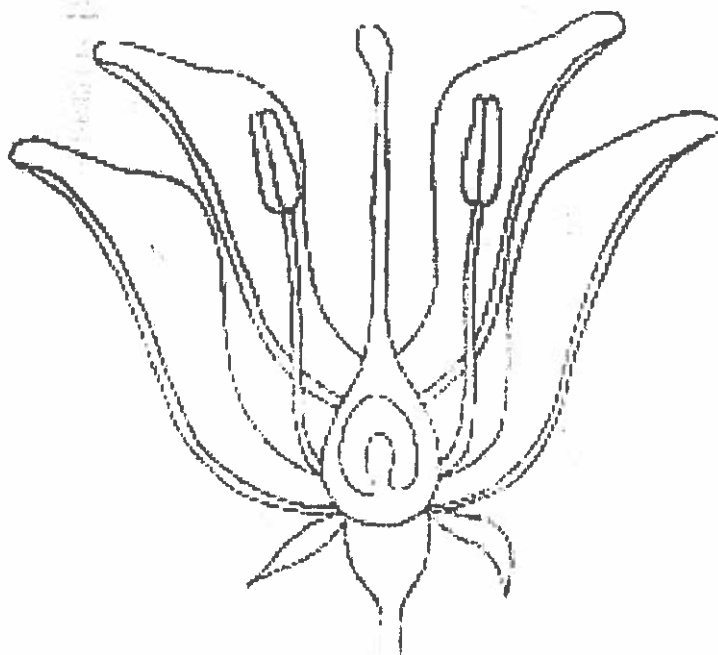
